 But "the music kinda wrote itself," says Thile. "It was a matter of finding the centre of what all of us could do. Yo-Yo doesn't improvise, and Stuart doesn't really read music. So it was kind of easy given the boundaries we had - while also trying to make it sound like it didn't have any boundaries at all!" (*Sony*)
